The annual National MED Week conference kicked-off this week (October 20-26) in Atlanta, where policymakers, MBEs, and their advocates collaborated on strategies for economic empowerment and long-term wealth creation.



L. S. Caldwell & Associates, Inc. has been selected to provide contracting and employment compliance on the Frederick Douglass Tunnel Program (FDTP). Under the leadership of the ADVANCE Team (AECOM and Jacobs), the FDTP aims to modernize and transform a 10-mile section of the Northeast Corridor (NEC) between Washington, D.C. and New Jersey over ten (10) years. It includes the construction of two new high-capacity tunnel tubes for electrified passenger trains, new bridges, track, rail systems, and infrastructure. The existing B&P Tunnel in Baltimore, which dates back to the Civil War era, will largely be replaced by the new Frederick Douglass Tunnel. The new tunnel will have two parallel, single-track tubes, each approximately two miles long, and will allow for faster travel speeds than the existing tunnel. The project will cost \$4.7 billion and aims to increase speeds from 30 mph to 110 mph, reducing delays on the entire NEC. It also includes new roadway and railroad bridges, track, rail systems, and infrastructure, as well as an ADA-accessible West Baltimore MARC Station.

L.S. Caldwell & Associates, Inc. (LSC) is charged with Compliance oversight for the project which includes identifying all aspects of contracting and employment compliance under federal, state and local legislation and ensuring all lower tier subcontractor participation. Additionally, LSC will monitor, track and report all compliance requirements including workforce development.

This new tunnel will provide enhanced Customer Benefits including:

- State-of-the-art tunnel for all-electric passenger trains
- Modernized rail infrastructure along 10 miles of the NEC
- New ADA-accessible West Baltimore MARC Station
- Improved travel times and reliability for MARC and Amtrak customers

- \$50 million Community Investment Program
- Modern fire/life safety systems
- · Improvements to West Baltimore roads and bridges
